Introduction

The Sacramento County Environmental Management Department (EMD) is certified by the California Department of Resources, Recycling, and Recovery (CalRecycle) to act as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) within the Cities and County of Sacramento. The LEA issues permits and enforces state laws and regulations at solid waste facilities. Please be advised that the Sacramento County LEA received and approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) Amendment application for the Sacramento Recycling and Transfer Station (SRTS).

Description of project and LEA's determination

SRTS is a large-volume transfer station and materials recovery facility (MRF) with a permitted capacity to receive 2,500 tons per day of non-hazardous municipal solid waste, green waste, construction and demolition (C&D) waste, food waste, and recyclables. SRTS is located 8491 Fruitridge Road, Sacramento, CA 95826 (APN 061-0173-028-0000).

On March 13, 2026, the LEA received an application package to amend the RFI to include the addition of an additional baler, an updated site map, along with minor updates which included changes to estimated equipment and personnel numbers during peak operating conditions, typographical changes, updated output calculations for increased baling capacity, and updates to the emergency contacts and station personnel list.

The LEA found the proposed changes to be consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) documents, applicable State Minimum Standards for Solid Waste Facilities, and pursuant to Titles 14 and 27 of the California Code of Regulations, does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current Solid Waste Facility Permit.

The LEA accepted the application and approved the RFI amendment on April 2, 2026.
