**Reference: Addendum Letter - Task 2 Offsite Sampling Report, City of Sacramento Mangan Rifle and Pistol Range Project, 2140 34<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Sacramento, CA**

Stantec Consulting Services Inc. (Stantec) has prepared this Addendum Letter pertaining to the *Task 2 Offsite Sampling Report* (Task 2 Report) prepared by Stantec and dated November 4, 2016. This Addendum Letter was requested by the County of Sacramento Environmental Management Department (Sacramento EMD) in electronic correspondence dated May 12, 2017 (attached). The intent of this letter is to clarify the project record regarding laboratory processing of soil samples collected from 29 residential properties in the Mangan Park neighborhood.

The *Task 2 Offsite Sampling Plan Addendum* (Stantec, September 21, 2016) described laboratory processing of soil samples collected using incremental sampling methodology (ISM). In addition to the laboratory's standard operating procedures (SOPs) for preparation of ISM samples prior to analysis, the sampling plan stated that samples would be additionally sieved through a #60 (0.250 millimeter [mm]) screen, based on previous request by Sacramento EMD. This additional sieving step was not followed in the laboratory; rather, samples were sieved using a #10 (2 mm) screen in accordance with the laboratory's SOPs. This detail was relayed to Sacramento EMD during subsequent project meetings, but was not included in the formal data deliverable, the *Task 2 Offsite Sampling Report* prepared by Stantec and dated November 4, 2016.

Hi Karl and Neil,

Charlie and I were talking about portions of the RAP, and we were discussing the difference between sieved and un-sieved samples. During the discussion, we went back and looked at the Task 2 Offsite Sampling Plan Addendum dated September 21, 2016, which specified that ISM samples would be sieved with a #60 sieve prior to analysis. It was noted in our subsequent in-person project meetings (but not documented in the record) that the work plan procedures were not followed for the ISM sampling, but were followed for the discrete samples.

Can you please submit an addendum to correct the record? Charlie and I were second-guessing ourselves as to what really happened as we reviewed the file. Thanks!
