

HEALTH PERMIT SUSPENSION DUE TO COCKROACHES

Recommended steps to be taken after a facility closure due to the presence of cockroaches

Request Pest Control Treatment

- ☐ Call for immediate, same day pest control service
- ☐ Prepare for treatment - make sure all food-related items are protected and follow any other instructions given by pest control operator
- ☐ Remove all dead and dying cockroaches including egg sacs
- ☐ Clean entire facility, especially floors before pest control treatment

Follow-Up On Treatment

- ☐ Follow instructions given by pest control operator
- ☐ Request follow-up pest control service to help evaluate before requesting reinspection

Evaluate Facility For Reinspection

- ☐ Ensure no live cockroaches are present
- ☐ Remove all dead/dying cockroaches
- ☐ Clean and sanitize food preparation surfaces and utensils, consult with pest control operator for cleaning procedures

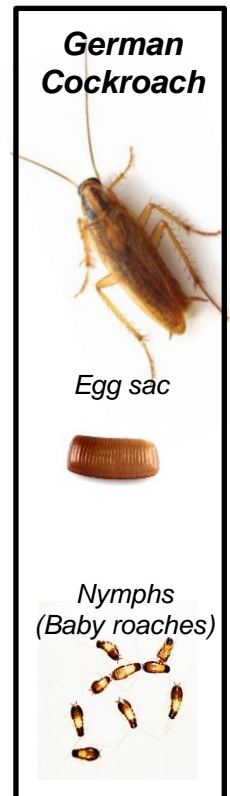
Reinspection

- ☐ Recommend completing all of the above before calling for reinspection

****Facility will not be allowed to reopen if live cockroaches are found during the reinspection****

Common Pest Control Treatment

- ☐ Recommended treatment components frequently include:
 - residual spray along cove base
 - micro inject flushing agent into cracks and crevices
 - place monitoring traps (glue traps) throughout facility
(Important: Do not mop floors after the above treatment)
- ☐ Follow-up steps that may be taken by or with pest control service operator:
 - Check all monitoring traps and evaluate how severe the infestation is
 - Monitoring traps with activity will pin point harborage areas
 - Replace any monitoring traps that have been removed/discarded
 - Remove harborage areas by sealing all cracks and crevices with approved materials (ex. silicone sealant)
