

MEDICAL WASTE INFORMATION DOCUMENT

In accordance with Section 117945 of the California Health and Safety Code (HSC), small quantity generators that are not onsite treatment facilities or common storage facilities must maintain onsite a medical waste information document. Information includes how the generator contains, stores, treats, and disposes of any medical waste generated through any act or process of the generator.
