MOBILE FOOD FACILITY PERMIT INSPECTIONS ARE BY APPOINTMENT ONLY

Schedule your inspection by calling (916) 875-8440

- > Inspections begin on **November 15th**.
- Permit renewals must be inspected and permitted by **January 31st** to avoid a late fee.
- New permits must be inspected and approved prior to operating.
- Inspections are conducted at Sacramento County Environmental Management Department; 11080 White Rock Rd. Suite 200, Rancho Cordova, CA 95670.
- Category D Mobile Food Facilities (MFF) that are new or have never been permitted in California, must submit a complete set of plans for review and approval prior to the issuance of the permit.


