

MOBILE FOOD FACILITY PERMIT INSPECTIONS ARE BY APPOINTMENT ONLY

Schedule your inspection by calling (916) 875-8440

- Inspections begin on **November 15th**.
- Permit renewals must be inspected and permitted by **January 31st** to avoid a late fee.
- New permits must be inspected and approved prior to operating.
- Inspections are conducted at **Sacramento County Environmental Management Department; 11080 White Rock Rd. Suite 200, Rancho Cordova, CA 95670.**
- **Category D Mobile Food Facilities (MFF) that are new or have never been permitted in California, must submit a complete set of plans for review and approval prior to the issuance of the permit.**

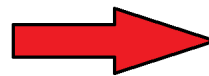

The following must be completed before an inspection can be scheduled:

- Occupiable food trucks must have an insignia from Department of Housing and Community Development prior to applying for a permit
- Completed Commissary form with signature
- Completed Restroom Verification with signature if parked at one location for more than 1 hour
- Completed Route Sheet (Category D Only)
- A Valid Food Safety Certificate (handling open potentially hazardous food)
- Food Handler Cards for all employees



NOTE: If a re-inspection is required, a fee of \$201 will be assessed.
