- Inspections will begin November 1st 2025
- All food trucks must be inspected and permitted by January 31, 2026
- Inspections will be conducted at Sacramento County Environmental Management Department; 11080 White Rock Rd., Suite 200, Rancho Cordova, CA 95670
- Permit fees must be paid before inspection is conducted

Mobile Food Facilities (MFF) applying for a new category (D) permit with the County of Sacramento must either show proof that they have been previously permitted in another county within the State of California or submit a complete set of plans to our department for review and approval prior to the issuance of the permit.

The following must be completed before an inspection can be scheduled:

- □ Food Truck must have an insignia from Department of Housing and Community Development □
- □ Completed commissary letter with signature
- ☐ Completed restroom verification with signature if parked at one location for more than 1 hour
- $\ \square$ Completed Route Sheet
- ☐ Food Safety Certificate for truck operator
- □ Food handler cards for all employees
- ☐ ALL EQUIPMENT MUST BE ON AND WORKING PROPERLY BEFORE APPOINTMENT TIME
- □ NOTE: If a reinspection is required, a fee of \$201 will be assessed
