Introduction

The Sacramento County Environmental Management Department (EMD) is certified by the California Department of Resources, Recycling, and Recovery (CalRecycle) to act as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) within the cities and County of Sacramento. The LEA issues permits and enforces State laws and regulations at solid waste facilities. Please be advised that the Sacramento County Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) Amendment application to the Solid Waste Facility Permit for the Kiefer Landfill.

Description of project and LEA's determination

The Kiefer Landfill is a solid waste disposal site with an LEA-permitted capacity to receive 10,815 tons per day of municipal solid waste. Kiefer Landfill is located at 12701 Kiefer Blvd, Sloughouse, CA 95683.

On February 14, 2024, the LEA received an application package to amend the facility's current RFI to add design capacity information, update tire derived aggregate storage and use parameters, update drainage plans near sediment basin B, update Air Quality Maintenance District protocols, update existing Leachate Collection and Removal System conditions, and update personnel information.

The LEA found the proposed changes to be consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) documents and applicable State Minimum Standards, pursuant to California Code of Regulations Titles 14 and 27, and do not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current Solid Waste Facility Permit.

The LEA accepted the application and approved the RFI amendment on March 15, 2024.
