Introduction

Please be advised that the Sacramento County Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) Amendment application for the Waste Management Recycle America, DBA K&M Recycling. The Sacramento County Environmental Management Department (EMD) is certified by the California Department of Resources, Recycling, and Recovery (CalRecycle) to act as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) within the Cities and County of Sacramento. The LEA issues permits and enforces state laws and regulations at solid waste facilities. Please be advised that the Sacramento County LEA received and approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) Amendment to the Solid Waste Facility Permit for K&M Recycling.

Description of project and LEA's determination

K&M Recycling is a green material composting facility and C&D debris processing facility that is currently closed to the public and is located at 3562 Ramona Avenue in Sacramento, CA 95826.

On September 11, 2020, the LEA received an RFI Amendment application package to amend the RFI. The amendment to the RFI was submitted in response to the Five Year Permit Review Report dated September 01, 2020. The changes to the RFI include updates to owner and management information; updates to the Fire Prevention and Protection Program, and expanded descriptions to reflect current site conditions and occasional storage of recyclable materials at the facility. The application was accepted by the LEA on October 09, 2020.

The LEA found the proposed changes to be consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) documents and applicable State Minimum Standards, pursuant to 27 CCR and 14 CCR, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current Solid Waste Facilities Permit.
