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## **Introduction**

Please be advised that the Sacramento County Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) Amendment application for the Sierra Waste Recycling & Transfer Station. The Sacramento County Environmental Management Department (EMD) is certified by the California Department of Resources, Recycling, and Recovery (CalRecycle) to act as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) within the Cities and County of Sacramento. The LEA issues permits and enforces state laws and regulations at solid waste facilities. Please be advised that the Sacramento County LEA received and approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) Amendment to the Solid Waste Facility Permit for Sierra Waste Recycling & Transfer Station.

## **Description of project and LEA's determination**

Sierra Waste & Recycling Transfer Station is a Large Volume Transfer/Processing Facility (MRF) located at 8260 Berry Avenue in Sacramento, CA 95828 currently operating in compliance with Solid Waste Facility Permit 34-AA-0214 to receive commercial and public waste including: construction and demolition debris, inert debris, recycled materials, non-curb-side collected green waste, wood waste, and mixed loads of waste.

On November 24, 2020, the LEA received an application package to amend the RFI. The changes to the RFI include updates to management information and numbers of facility personnel on-site during operation, updates for adding a third scale to the onsite equipment, updates to maximum number of incoming vehicles per day to reflect specifications and conditions of the SWFP, and the removal of mulch processing and storage information from operations. The application was accepted by the LEA on December 22, 2020.

The LEA found the proposed changes to be consistent with, but not limited to, all applicable certified and/or adopted California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) documents and applicable State Minimum Standards, pursuant to 27 CCR and 14 CCR, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current Solid Waste Facilities Permit.
