**Introduction**

Please be advised that the Sacramento County Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) Amendment application for the Elder Creek Transfer Station to revise the facility's Transfer Processing Report (TPR). The LEA is certified by the

California Integrated Waste Management Board to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the County and City of Sacramento, including transfer stations.

### **Description of project and LEA's determination**

Elder Creek Recovery and Transfer Station is a large volume transfer station located at 8642 Elder Creek Rd in Sacramento, CA 95828. On July 7, 2020, the LEA received a RFI amendment application package to revise the TPR in order to address the installation of a compressed natural gas (CNG) fueling system. The revisions were accepted by the LEA on August 6, 2020.

The LEA found the proposed changes to be consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) documents and applicable State Minimum Standards, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current Solid Waste Facilities Permit.
