Introduction

Please be advised that the Sacramento County Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) Amendment application for the North Area Recovery Station to revise the facility's Transfer Processing Report (TPR). The Sacramento County Environmental Management Department (EMD) is certified by the California Department of Resources, Recycling, and Recovery (CalRecycle) to act as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) within the cities and County of Sacramento. EMD is authorized by Division 30 of the Public Resources Code (PRC), § 43209, and Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations (14 CCR), § 18051 and § 18084, to enforce solid waste laws and regulations in Sacramento County.

Description of project and LEA's determination

North Area Recovery Station (NARS) is a large volume transfer station located at 4450 Roseville Road, North Highlands, CA 95660. On September 26, 2022 the LEA received an RFI amendment application package to revise the TPR in order to address the construction and operation of a 60,000 square foot Commercial Waste Building, a bypass road south of the building, and the removal of one truck wash bay. Revisions also include the addition of SB1383 regulatory sections. The revisions were accepted by the LEA on October 25, 2022.

The LEA found the proposed changes to be consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) documents and applicable State Minimum Standards, and do not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current Solid Waste Facilities Permit.
