Introduction

Please be advised that the Sacramento County Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) Amendment application for Lopez Agricultural Services Composting and Soil Blending Facility (DBA Sacramento Composting and Recycling Facility) to revise the facility's Report of Composting Site Information (RCSI). The LEA is certified by the California Integrated Waste Management Board to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the County and City of Sacramento, including composting facilities.

Description of project and LEA's determination

Lopez Agricultural Services Composting and Soil Blending Facility is a composting facility located at 11499 Florin Road in Sacramento, CA 95830. On June 26, 2024, LEA staff received an RFI Amendment application package for an amendment to the Report of Composting Site Information (RCSI) for Lopez Agricultural Services, Inc., located at 11499 Florin Road in Sacramento, California.

The RFI amendment is a proposed RCSI revision to address relocation of material and onsite activities to a smaller portion of the current working area while Vulcan Materials (land owner) mines areas currently used for gypsum processing/stockpiling, soil blending/processing, and green waste processing. All activities currently conducted on an approximate 40-acre footprint will be condensed onto an approximate 20-acre footprint that has been historically used for organic composting. Activities will expand back out to the current 40 acre working area or similar working areas once Vulcan Materials finishes mining the soil and rebuilds the working pads.

LEA staff reviewed the application package and found that the proposed revisions do not conflict with the terms and conditions of the Solid Waste Facility Permit, are consistent with State Minimum Standards, and are consistent with applicable CEQA documents. As such, the revisions were accepted by the LEA on July 16, 2024.
