The Sacramento County Environmental Management Department (EMD) is certified by the California Department of Resources, Recycling, and Recovery (CalRecycle) to act as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) within the cities and County of Sacramento. EMD is authorized by Division 30 of the Public Resources Code (PRC), Section 43209, and Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations (CCR), Sections 18051 and 18084, to enforce solid waste laws and regulations.

Project Description: Proposal to modify the Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) and amend the facility's Transfer Processing Report (TPR), as follows:

- Remove specific permit conditions which limit the maximum amount of recyclables and mixed waste the facility can receive on a daily basis while remaining within the total maximum daily permitted tonnage specified in the current SWFP for the facility
- Amend the existing TPR for the facility to reflect the proposed permit changes.

LEA Determination: The LEA has determined that the proposed change to the SWFP is a nonmaterial change, as defined by 27 CCR, section 21563(d)(5), and as such, requires modification of the SWFP pursuant to section 21665(d) of Title 27, of the California Code of Regulations, and is deemed to be consistent with the state minimum standards for solid waste facilities as outlined in Title 14, Title 27, and PRC 44000, and with current applicable CEQA findings. Per 27 CCR, section 21650(g), the LEA will modify the existing SWFP to reflect the proposed changes and submit a draft copy of the modified SWFP to CalRecycle for concurrence within 60 days of accepting the application package as complete and correct.
