The Sacramento County Environmental Management Department (EMD) is certified by the California Department of Resources, Recycling, and Recovery (CalRecycle) to act as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) within the cities and County of Sacramento. EMD is authorized by Division 30 of the Public Resources Code (PRC), Section 43209, and Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations (CCR), Sections 18051 and 18084, to enforce solid waste laws and regulations.

Project Description: Proposal to modify the Solid Waste Facility Permit and amend the facility's Transfer Processing Report (TPR), as follows:

- **Remove permit condition 17h**, which limits pile temperatures from reaching 122 degrees Fahrenheit,
- **Report of Facility Information**, to amend related language in TPR to reflect the proposed changes.

LEA Determination: The LEA has determined that the proposed change to the SWFP is a nonmaterial change, as defined by 27 CCR, section 21563(d)(5), and as such, requires modification of the SWFP pursuant to section 21665(d) of Title 27, of the California Code of Regulations, and is deemed to be consistent with the state minimum standards for solid waste facilities as outlined in Title 14, Title 27, and PRC 44000, and with current applicable CEQA findings. Per 27 CCR, section 21650(g), the LEA will draft and submit the modified SWFP to CalRecycle for concurrence by January 9, 2022.
