Introduction

Please be advised that the County of Sacramento Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and approved an Amendment to the Transfer Processing Report (TPR) for the South Area Transfer Station (SATS). The LEA is certified by the California Department of Resources, Recycling, and Recovery (CalRecycle) to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste facilities within the County and City of Sacramento.

Description of project and LEA's determination

LEA staff received an application package to amend the TPR for SATS on September 30, 2021. The application was accepted by the LEA on October 28, 2012. The amendment to the TPR is comprised of minor updates which include removing references to the former Clean World organization which operated an anaerobic biodigester on the site, updating historical information regarding RFI amendments, correcting subleased combined acreage numbers, and updating the mailing address and facility management organization table. Site Maps were also updated to reflect the finished Atlas building, the closing off of the south gate, and the addition of the CNG slow fill stations and underground gas lines, etc.

Pursuant to California Code of Regulations Title 27 (27 CCR), Section 21665, the LEA approved and filed the amendment to the TPR, without a revision to the permit, based upon the following criteria:

- 1) The proposed changes are consistent with all applicable certified CEQA documents;
- 2) The proposed changes are acceptable and consistent with, but not limited to, state minimum standards, pursuant to Chapter 3 of 27 CCR and Chapter 3 of 14 CCR; and
- 3) The changes do not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current SWFP.
