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**Introduction**

Please be advised that the Sacramento County Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) Amendment application for Elder Creek Transfer

and Recovery to revise the facility's Transfer Processing Report (TPR). The LEA is certified by the California Integrated Waste Management Board to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the County and City of Sacramento, including transfer stations.

### **Description of project and LEA's determination**

Elder Creek Transfer and Recovery is a large volume transfer station located at 8642 Elder Creek Rd in Sacramento, CA 95828. On April 1, 2022, the LEA received a RFI amendment application package to revise the TPR in order to address the installation of an outdoor canopy along the southwest side of the building over an existing green waste unloading area. The area under the canopy will be used for the unloading of the new source separated organic green container waste stream created by SB1383. The TPR revisions were accepted by the LEA on April 29, 2022.

The LEA found the proposed changes to be consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) documents, applicable State Minimum Standards, and do not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current Solid Waste Facility Permit.
