Watt Avenue Recycling and Material Recovery Facility

Introduction

The Sacramento County Environmental Management Department (EMD) is certified by the California Department of Resources, Recycling, and Recovery (CalRecycle) to act as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) within the cities and County of Sacramento. The LEA issues permits and enforces State laws and regulations at solid waste facilities. Please be advised that the Sacramento County Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) Amendment application to the Solid Waste Facility Permit for the Watt Avenue Recycling and Material Recovery Facility (WARMRF), formerly named Recycling Industries.

Description of project and LEA's determination

The WARMRF is a large-volume transfer station and material recovery facility with an LEA-permitted capacity to receive 400 tons per day of mixed recyclable material. The WARMRF is located at 4741 Watt Avenue, North Highlands, CA 95660.

On January 24, 2024, the LEA received an application package to amend the facility's current RFI to change the facility's name and update ownership and operator information. This change was necessary to reflect the upcoming ownership change that was scheduled to occur on February 1, 2024.

The LEA found the proposed changes to be consistent with the project description, compliant with applicable California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) documents, compliant with applicable State Minimum Standards pursuant to California Code of Regulations, Titles 14 and 27, and compliant with the conditions outlined in the current Solid Waste Facility Permit.

The LEA accepted the application and approved the RFI amendment on February 1, 2024.
