Update on Ebola


Preparedness/response

- Traveler monitoring – 98 to date
- Coordination plans with medical community for emergency preparation
- 2 treatment hospitals designated as treatment hospitals
- Public health lab testing of specimens
- Coordinated testing of 4 suspect cases
- Working with Sheriff, PD, DA, OES, FBI, Probation to update isolation and quarantine plan

Recent Communicable Disease Outbreaks

- E Coli 0157 outbreak involving children in daycare center (7)
- Norovirus outbreak in restaurant (16)
- Multistate outbreak of *Salmonella* Poona infections (2 in Sac)
 - 285 people infected with the outbreak strain have been reported from 27 states (mainly southwestern states).
 - 54% of ill people are younger than 18 years.
 - For 160 people with available information, 53 (33%) reported being hospitalized. One death has been reported.




Current concern – opioid abuse
